High Speed Rail (London - West Midlands) Bill: Additional Land Requirements

We wrote to you in November 2014 to advise you that we are considering making a number of changes to the High Speed Rail (London - West Midlands) Bill. These changes follow our discussions with petitioners, and aim to address their concerns. We intend to implement the changes by depositing an Additional Provision (AP) to the Bill during the next Parliament.

We are writing to you now to confirm the changes currently proposed within your Council area that are likely to be brought forward in the AP. We are also communicating details of the proposals to affected Local Authorities and Parish Councils. These changes are:

- Infrastructure to the north east of Langley railway station to accommodate the relocated Heathrow Express Depot in the Borough of Slough. Associated infrastructure extends into the parish of Iver.
- Additional land for the realignment of an access track in the parish of Denham.
- Provision of an access track to drainage infrastructure in the parish of Denham.
- Additional land for tunnel infrastructure works in the parish of Little Missenden.
- Additional land for the reconfiguration of an access track in the parishes of Wendover and The Lee.
- Reconfiguration of drainage infrastructure in the parish of Great Missenden.
- Realignment of Footpaths LMI/21 and GMI/23 in the parishes of Great Missenden and Little Missenden.
- Realignment of Footpath GMI/13/1 in the parish of Great Missenden.
- Additional land for an access track to drainage infrastructure in the parish of Great Missenden.
- Additional land for the reconfiguration of a junction at Old Risborough Road in the parish of Stoke Mandeville.
- Additional land for noise mitigation on the A4010 Stoke Mandeville Bypass in the parish of Stoke Mandeville.
- Provision of field access at Moat Farm in the parish of Stoke Mandeville.
- Additional land for an access track to drainage infrastructure at Wendover Dean in the parish of Wendover.
- Additional land for the provision of a replacement cricket ground and pavilion in the parish of Wendover.
- Additional land for the relocation of Quainton Grid Supply Point in the parish of Quainton.

- Additional land to provide replacement railway infrastructure in the parishes of Steeple Claydon and Calvert Green.
- Additional land to upgrade an existing access track for maintenance purposes in the parish of Chetwode.
- Upgrade of a bridge carrying Bridleway QUA/28A to also carry farm vehicles in the parish of Quainton.
- Additional land for drainage infrastructure in the parish of Quainton.
- Realignment of Footpath TWY/18 in the parish of Twyford.
- Additional land for the diversion of an access road for the Energy from Waste plant in the parish of Quainton.
- Realignment of Bridleway SCL/18 in the parishes of Calvert Green and Steeple Claydon.
- Additional land for the provision of a replacement playing field in the parish of Turweston.
- Additional land for the provision of a diversion during the closure of School End in the parish of Chetwode.
- Realignment of farm access tracks in the parish of Barton Hartshorn.
- Closure of Byway PBI/5A/2 with provision of a replacement access road in the parish of Preston Bissett.
- Realignment of an access road off West Street in the parish of Twyford.

Deposit of the AP

We will be in touch with you soon to confirm the timing and other arrangements for the deposit of the AP. Please could you confirm that you are still the contact for the Council and that we may deposit the AP at the location nominated during the initial Bill deposit. Thank you if you have already provided us with this information.

It remains possible that our ongoing engagement with petitioners and interested parties could result in further changes being proposed, either in this AP or in a future AP. We will endeavour to keep you informed of any such changes.
